Greatest Glasgow Awards is delighted to announce the Winner of the 2018 Best Glasgow House of Worship: ST MUNGO'S CATHEDRAL.

The 2018 Winner of the Award of the Best House of Worship in Glasgow is St Mungo's Cathedral.

The second Winner is St Vincent Street Church.

The third Winner is Garnethill Synagogue.

The fourth and fifth Winners are St Mary's Cathedral and Hindu Mandir.

The remaining Winners are St Andre's Cathedral, Glasgow Central Mosque and Gurdwara Singh Sabha.

Greatest Glasgow Awards has announced today the winners for the category of 2018 Best Houses of Worship in Glasgow.

The research has involved staff of Greatest Glasgow reviewing 20 temples and using 20 criteria to find the excellence and award the winners.

St Mungo's Cathedral is a magnificent medieval Gothic building built during the 13th-15th centuries on the site where St. Kentigern – known as Mungo, a missionary in the 6th century who converted the Picts to Christianity, and the founder and patron saint of the city of Glasgow – was buried.

St. Vincent Street Church was designed by Alexander “Greek” Thomson in 1859 for the former United Presbyterian Church of Scotland. The responsible for the interior decoration was Daniel Cottier, a favourite of Thomson.

The Synagogue was built in the period of 1879-81 by architects John McLeod and Nathan Solomon Joseph. The exterior of this Category A listed building is Romanesque revival, and the interior features Byzantine revival details, with a splendid Torah-Ark.

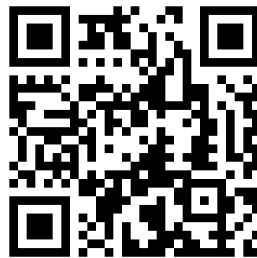
The architect Sir George Gilbert Scott was commissioned to this Gothic Revival building opened for worship in 1871 as St. Mary’s Episcopal Church.

Built by Scottish architect Charles Wilson in 1857, this building, in July 2006 they converted the upper floor and was inaugurated as Hindu Mandir.
