Greatest Glasgow Awards is delighted to announce the Winner of the 2018 Best Public Clock in Glasgow category: GLASGOW CENTRAL STATION.

The 2018 Winner of the Award of the Best Public Clock in Glasgow is Central Station.

The second Winner is Tolbooth Steeple.

The third Winner is St. Andrew's in the Square.

The fourth and fifth Winners are Hutchesons' Hall and Charing Cross Mansions

Greatest Glasgow Awards has announced today the winners for the category of 2018 Best Public Clocks in Glasgow.

The research has involved staff of Greatest Glasgow reviewing 98 clocks and using 14 criteria to find the excellence and award the winners.

Glasgow Central Station, opened in 1879, is full of architectural details, but the 15ft high four-faces clock suspended from an iron riveted gilder that supports the glass roof is probably the most noticeable and popular attribute.

The 126ft Tolbooth Steeple clock, the only surviving part of the 17th century Tolbooth building, has witnessed marketplaces, proclamations and public hangings throughout Glasgow history.

St. Andrew's in the Square is widely regarded as one of the finest classical churches in Britain. It was built between 1739-1756, and was recently transformed into the Glasgow's Centre for Scottish Culture.

Located in the Merchant City area, Hutchesons' Hospital was built between 1802-05 by the Scottish architect David Hamilton, although it was never used as such. In June


2014 it was refurbished and opened as a three flooring dining venue, Hutchesons City Grill.

And lastly, Charing Cross Mansions, a great red sandstone tenement. It contains a centrepiece baroque clock with several fines sculptures bordering the clock.
