Greatest Glasgow Awards is delighted to announce the Winner of the 2018 Best Police Box in Glasgow category: CATHEDRAL SQUARE POLICE BOX

The 2018 Winner of the Award of the Best Police Box in Glasgow is the Cathedral Square Police Box.

The second Winner is the Sauchiehall Street Police Box.

The third Winner is the Botanic Garden Police Box.

Greatest Glasgow Awards has announced today the winners for the category of 2018 Best Police Box in Glasgow.

The research has involved staff of Greatest Glasgow reviewing 8 places and using 16 criteria to find the excellence and award the winners.

Located near the majestic Glasgow Cathedral and The Provand's Lordship, the winner is a distinctive landmark and an integral part of the streetscape. In 1933 it was built and now is a coffee kiosk named Empire Coffee Box.

In 2014, an original red police box was displayed inside the old Glasgow's Transport Museum was placed in the middle of Sauchiehall Street, just near the junction with Renfield Street, looking splendid in its original red colour. It is currently a shop named CBD Tardis.

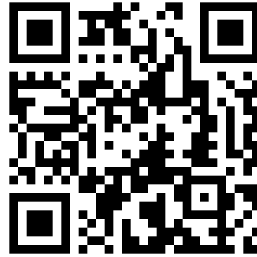
Finally, the police box situated at the Northwest corner of the junction of Great Western Road and Queen Margaret Drive, at the entrance to the Botanic Gardens, was put into service in November 1933, just one month after the one in Cathedral Square.
