Greatest Glasgow Awards is delighted to announce the Winner of the 2018 Best Christmas Decorations in Glasgow category: HOUSE OF FRASER

The 2018 Winner of the Award of the Best Christmas Decoration in Glasgow is House of Fraser.

The second Winner is Argyll Arcade.

The third Winner is Princes Square.

The fourth and fifth Winners are St. Enoch Centre and George Square.

Greatest Glasgow Awards has announced today the winners for the category of 2018 Best Christmas Decorations in Glasgow.

The research has involved staff of Greatest Glasgow reviewing 38 Christmas decorations and using 15 criteria to find the excellence and award the winners.

House of Fraser has a long and distinguished history. It was founded in 1849, when partners Hugh Fraser and James Arthur opened a small drapery shop on the corner of Argyle Street and Buchanan Street in Glasgow. Currently it's the third largest group of traditional department stores in the UK.

Designed by John Baird and built in 1827, the Argyll Arcade - one of Europe's oldest covered shopping arcades - provides a link between Buchanan Street and Argyle Street and was designed in the Parisian-style and early Victorian architecture with a glass roof.

Princes Square was built in 1841 by John Baird and other architects. The original buildings consisted of a 4 storey merchant square built in yellow sandstone. It was reconfigured and extended the space to turn it into an iconic shopping centre in 1987.

Built between 1986 and 1989 by GMW Architects and Sir Robert McAlpine, the St. Enoch Centre is a shopping mall. It replaced St Enoch station, that was the mainline railway station in the city of Glasgow between 1876 and 1966 and was demolished in 1977.

George Square is named after King George III. It is the principal urban square in Glasgow and has been the acknowledged centre of the city's public life for centuries.
